### Novatex delivers the Agritechnica prize

The winner of the Comprima roundbaler is Mr. Neite-meier, contractor.

Spelle (Germany), February 2010 – A Krone Comprima CV 150 XC roundbaler, worth 75.000 Euro, was presented to the lucky winners, contractors Messrs Hermann and Klaus Neite-meier from Wadersloh-Diestedde (North Rhine-Westphalia). At last November's Agritechnica exhibition, Mr. Hermann Neite-meier took part in the Novatex competition; Novatex is a manufacturer of high-quality netwraps and a supplier of Krone roundbalers, which had offered as first prize a Comprima F 155 XC model.

As the Neitemeier brothers deal mainly with silage, they asked for a different model, more precisely a Comprima CV 150 XC. The price difference between the round-baler to be won and the Comprima delivered to the two brothers was obviously borne by them, both managing directors of their own company.

At the official delivery of their prize, the two brothers also took the opportunity to visit Krone's production site, and were very impressed. "Anyone visiting this plant can appreciate what kind of innovations Krone implements comprise. We are happy we'll be using a renowned Krone roundbaler during next season" was the Neitemeier brothers' conclusion.

The Comprima V 150 [CV 150?], variable chamber, with X-Cut (XC) cutting equipment, can produce bales with 1.00 to 1.50 mt [m = metre] diameter. The innovative Novogrip Press System is a particular feature of Comprima. The Novogrip system, a worldwide exclusive, consists of special rubber-treaded fabric belts in combination with horizontal slats, working either as rotation and [or?] compression parts. Thanks to this combination, Comprima represents the benefits of the barred chain technology and the twin-arm wrapper.
